Tertiary Grant for Children of Permanently Employed Public Sector Teachers (Academic Year: September 2023 – July 2024)

Public Sector Teachers who are members of the Jamaica Teachers' Association (JTA) are invited to apply for the 2023 - 2024 Tertiary Grant.

The total value of the grant will be determined by the Central Executive/General Council in consultation with the Ministry of Education and Youth.

The following guidelines should be noted:

- 1. The grant is applicable to permanently employed public sector teachers who are members of the Jamaica Teachers' Association.
- 2. The grant is for children of Public Sector Teachers who have been accepted to pursue or are pursuing local, full-time undergraduate accredited programme at a Tertiary Institution, registered by the University Council of Jamaica (UCJ) and are not older than 30 years.
- 3. The submission of the following documents are mandatory:
 - a. Completed Application Form
 - b. Applicant's Employment Letter
 - c. Acceptance letter for new students
 - d. Transcript/Progress Report for continuing students
 - e. Copy of child's Birth Certificate reflecting the name of the parent making the application

NB: Previous recipients of this grant are not eligible.
