**Tertiary Grant for Basic School Teachers who are
Permanently Employed in the Public Educational System
(Academic Year: September 2023 – July 2024)**

Basic School Teachers who are members of the Jamaica Teachers' Association (JTA) are invited to apply for the 2023 - 2024 Tertiary Grant.

The total value of the grant will be determined by the Central Executive/General Council in consultation with the Ministry of Education, Youth and Information.

The following guidelines should be noted:

- 1. The grant is applicable to permanently employed Basic School Teachers who are members of the Jamaica Teachers' Association.**
- 2. The grant is for Basic School Teachers who have been accepted to pursue or are pursuing local, full-time accredited programmes at a Tertiary Institution registered by the University Council of Jamaica (UCJ).**
- 3. The submission of the following documents are mandatory:**
 - a. Completed Application Form
 - b. Applicant's Employment Letter
[employment letter will be accepted from the institution]
 - c. Acceptance letter for new students
 - d. Transcript/Progress Report for continuing students
 - e. Copy of National ID

NB: Previous recipients of this grant are not eligible
